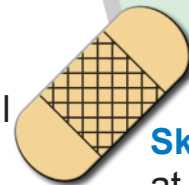

- Bites and stings
- **Broken bones - simple fractures**
- Cuts and lacerations
- Infected wounds
- Minor burns and scalds
- Muscle and joint injuries
- Removal of foreign bodies from eyes
- Sprains and strains
- Stitching, gluing and other wound closures
- **X-ray.**

at The Concourse Shopping Centre is for conditions including:

- Contraceptive advice
- Cuts and wounds
- Men's health problems
- Simple strains and sprains
- Skin complaints - rashes and sunburn
- Staying healthy e.g. blood pressure checks
- Stomach ache, indigestion, vomiting and diarrhoea
- Women's health problems, e.g. thrush, menstrual advice.
